


WHY NEW UNIFORMS?

Dansville's current uniforms have served the school well for more than 30 years and are due for retirement. New uniforms will result in a marked enhancement in perception of the band by audiences and adjudicators alike.

Furthermore, this improvement will broaden the appeal of band at Dansville Schools and encourage new students to study music, which has a measurable, positive effect on academic achievement and quality of life.

A TRADITION OF EXCELLENCE


Every element of the new uniform design draws inspiration from the band program's historic nine decades of *Excellence in Music Education*.

The "West Point" jacket, brass buckles, and contrasting trousers imitate the Aggie Band's military style of the 1940s and 50s. White spats worn over black shoes revive tradition from the 1960s, 70s and 80s. The cross-belt resembles the "belt and banner" marching coat used for the last three decades under director *David Norman*.

The design was selected through a competitive bid process between three manufacturers. The new uniforms will be made in the USA.

INVEST IN EXCELLENCE
